Please join us in Milwaukee for four days of stellar music-making, learning, and connecting with choral colleagues.

Joining Voices is all about the process of making connections both within and between singers from various walks of life. All aspects of the conference are designed to help choral conductors/teachers increase the richness of their work with singers. We seek to represent the primary ACDA Repertoire and Resource areas—Youth, Collegiate, Lifelong, and Repertoire-Specific (Men's, Women's, Jazz, Ethnic, Contemporary/Commercial)—with a diverse, broad representation of performances and interest sessions that explore the potential for choral organizations and ensembles to create rich, rewarding, and meaningful connections between singers, audiences, and communities. We are particularly interested in highlighting ensembles and programs that represent underserved populations and/or diversities. Further, the conference will highlight innovative choral programming and practices.

The conference begins on Wednesday, March 4th, with Immersion Day: a day focused on working with singers who have a variety of specific needs, with special emphasis on creating meaningful connections between singers with varying abilities. Immersion Day will include sessions that focus on the unique opportunities and challenges related to building singing communities whose members have particular learning and performance needs. Participants will also have the opportunity to observe rehearsals of an honor choir that will be a first in ACDA conference history—the *Joining Voices Choir*. The *Joining Voices Choir* will be led by Anton Armstrong, with integrated body singing sessions led by Therees Hibbard.

Throughout the conference, you will not only hear inspiring performances (all in the incredible Marcus Center), but you will also learn from inspiring master clinicians, most of whom engage in choral music making within the Central and North Central Region's elementary, secondary, and post-secondary schools and lead church and community choirs throughout the region.

If you are eager to help your singers connect to one another in meaningful ways, to help them sound better, to sing with greater artistry, to better connect their musical "doing" with their musical thinking and feeling, and to value the role music plays in their lives and in the lives of our communities, then *Joining Voices* is for YOU!

Honor Choirs

In addition to the *Joining Voices Honor Choir*, the Central -North Central ACDA Conference will host four honors choirs: a Children's Honor Choir (Grades 4-6) conducted by Angela Broeker; a Middle Level Honor Choir (Grades 6-8) led by Tim Fredstrom and Carol Krueger, and High School Level SSAA and TTBB Honor Choirs, led by Glen Thomas Rideout and Jessica Napoles, respectively. In addition, Lynne Gackle will work with collegiate ACDA attendees in the C-NC Collegiate Repertoire Choir.

The Collegiate Repertoire Choir aims to introduce collegiate singers to excellent choral repertoire, to provide singers and conferees the opportunity to observe a master clinician in rehearsal of this repertoire, to encourage collegiate choristers to make contacts with established professionals and each other, and to encourage college students to participate in ACDA early in their careers. The format allows an upbeat and energetic pace without the pressure and logistical concerns of performance. The Collegiate Repertoire Choir will meet onsite for several hours on Friday, and is directly preceded by a working lunch interest session tailored specifically for college students and new teachers.

Immersion Day

Joining Voices Inclusive Honor Choir. The primary purpose of this experience is to provide and model an inclusive music-making opportunity wherein individual contributions are valued, musical growth is championed, and all members become partners in the choral experience. Participants (high school - college age; ages 13-24) will be chosen based on ACDA member nomination and singers are expected to register in cross-ability pairs who plan to participate in the ensemble together. One member of each pair must be a singer who experiences physical, sensory, or cognitive challenges.

The High Five Choir is a blended choir of all abilities from both general and special education populations that come together through music building long-standing friendships, raising disability awareness and serving as agents of change for our school, community and world. Interest sessions will take place at various points throughout the day. The focus of these sessions will be on working with individuals with disabilities who participate in inclusive choir settings. The day will culminate in performances by both the *Joining Voices* and *High Five Choirs*.

Research

The Joining Voices Conference will also provide opportunities for the research community to engage in in-depth conversation, inquiry, and consideration of future research directions. Research papers and posters will focus on advancing knowledge and practice with respect to choral singing, choir sound, choral pedagogy, the sociology of choral singing, and more.

Reading Sessions

The reading sessions for *Joining Voices* will represent the primary ACDA Repertoire and Resource areas —Youth, Collegiate, Lifelong, and Repertoire-Specific (Men's, Women's, Jazz, Ethnic, Contemporary/ Commercial)—with a diverse, broad representation of literature that will increase the potential for choral organizations and ensembles to create rich, rewarding, and meaningful connections between singers, audiences, and communities.

Special Event:

Sing Wisconsin!—featuring collaborative performances by choral organizations, including a MKE City Honor Choir, a one-day event for Milwaukee teachers and students.

North Central and Central Regions continue to thrive and grow, and we are managing joint efforts toward a successful 2020 Conference. We continue to renew our commitment to lifelong music making through the choral art. Supporting our new and veteran teachers, providing opportunities to hear and create choral music at a high artistic level, and providing opportunities for professional growth and development are central to the mission of the organization.
